Camp CHECK -IN

An orientation for players and parents is conducted followed by a "full day". The camp will end on the ice at 5pm daily.

Medical Form

The form can be printed from our website (<u>www.mitchkorn.com</u>) under the CAMP FORMS tab. <u>DO NOT MAIL</u> <u>IT BACK</u>. Bring it with you <u>totally completed</u> to <u>Check-In on the first morning</u>. Players cannot skate without it!

Lunches

The Arena will offer a lunch package. We encourage all to purchase the package to make it financially feasible for the Arena and so the goalies can eat together. We will send all participants an email with the details when they are finalized. You CAN, however, bring your own lunch. With the large size of our group and time limitations, individual lunch orders at the restaurant cannot be taken.

BONUS...Extra Ice Time:

Each day 2-4 goalies are chosen for "extra ice time" to tend net for the "Defense Program" during the goalie's lunch break. Those chosen will eat lunch after the 1.5 hr. ice session.

<u>Equipment</u>

Remember, all goalies must have, and properly wear, full, legal equipment. We will provide the on-ice jersey. For the off-ice activities, all goalies need sweats/shorts along with **dry** socks, t-shirt, and undergarments. *At least 1 dry change of garments is required*.

Balance of Fees

Your **Registration/Confirmation acceptance was e-mailed to you.** Most pay a **Tuition Deposit** (\$100) to register. The **Balance of Fees** remain. Any Balance of Fees along with a 5% "registration fee on the full tuition" will be charged to the credit card on file on **May 5.** All fees are in U.S. funds. Any change in credit card account numbers can be revised by following directions below.

Refund Policy

- All cancellations must be made via a phone call or e-mail directly to Mitch Korn.
- All camp tuition (deposit and balance of fees) is accompanied by a 5% "Registration Fee" charged by the on-line service to cover credit card and administrative costs. All "Registration Fees" and your \$100 tuition deposit are **non-refundable** & **non-transferable**.
- All "balance of fees" (tuition minus the \$100 deposit) will be refunded up to **3 weeks** (21 days) prior to the day camp begins with a written doctor's medical excuse. After that point, 80% of these "balance of fees" will be refunded with notification prior to the **7 DAYS BEFORE** camp begins.
- There is **no refund** of any fees should a player drop out of camp for any reason within the **7 days before camp begins, or after camp starts**.
- Should a player be asked to leave camp by the Director for any reason, no refund will be made.
- All refunds will be credited back to the family credit card used to register.

Locker rooms

We expect all players to **RESPECT** the facility, the staff, and the other participants. For females participating in the program, separate locker room facilities will be available. All players should be able to dress themselves. Parents, please refrain from entering the locker rooms...space is very tight. Parental assistance is allowed outside the locker rooms only.

The Final Day

We will have a ceremony on the final day of camp. All the parents are welcome. The ceremony is tentatively scheduled for 5:15. Awards will be presented.
