Thank you for enrolling in our program. This is our **FINAL INFORMATION SHEET** for the camp (listed above) which provides all the important details of which you need to be aware (below). Camp CHECK-IN and orientation:

Sunday, July 18 @ 7:40am. An orientation for players and parents will follow.

A full day will follow. Camp ends between 5:00 and 5:30pm daily based on the group. Please pick up your goalie promptly after their completion.

Medical Form

The form can be printed from our website (www.mitchkorn.com) under the **CAMP FORMS** tab. **DO NOT MAIL IT BACK.** Bring it with you **totally completed** to **Check-In on the first morning.** Players cannot skate without it!

Lunches

The **HYDE PARK Ice Pavilion** will have a daily lunch special. The camp lunch package can be **purchased at CHECK-IN Sunday morning.** It is much easier to feed all the goalies when everyone is having the same lunch. Outside food is not allowed to be brought into the building unless required due to food allergies. ***We will email the details to all goalies prior to camp.***

Balance of Fees

All those who "rolled over" from 2020 are paid in full. For all those newly enrolled for 2021, your **Registration/Confirmation acceptance was e-mailed to you.** Most pay a **Tuition Deposit** (\$100) to register. The **Balance of Fees** remain. Any Balance of Fees along with a 5% "registration fee on the full tuition" will be charged to the credit card on file on **May 5.** All fees are in U.S. funds. Any change in credit card account numbers can be revised by following directions below.

Refund Policy

- All cancellations must be made via a phone call or e-mail directly to Mitch Korn.
- All camp tuition (deposit and balance of fees) is accompanied by a 5% "Registration Fee" charged by the on-line service to cover credit card and administrative costs. All "Registration Fees" and your \$100 tuition deposit are **non-refundable & non-transferable**.
- All "balance of fees" (tuition minus the \$100 deposit) will be refunded up to **3 weeks** (21 days) prior to the day camp begins with a written doctor's medical excuse. After that point, 80% of these "balance of fees" will be refunded with notification prior to the **7 DAYS BEFORE** camp begins.
- There is **no refund** of any fees should a player drop out of camp for any reason within the **7 days before camp begins, or after camp starts**.
- Should a player be asked to leave camp by the Director for any reason, no refund is made.
- All refunds will be credited back to the family credit card used to register.
- ***Special circumstances could exist based on how the Public Health situation evolves. More later.***

Locker rooms

We expect all players to **RESPECT** the facility, the staff and the other participants. For females participating in the program, separate locker room facilities will be available. All players should be able to dress themselves. Parents, please refrain from entering the locker rooms...space is very tight. Parental assistance is allowed outside the locker rooms, only.

Host Hotel

We have an awesome **HOST HOTEL** in an amazing area. **The Niagara Crossing Hotel & Spa @ 100 Center Street, Lewiston, New York, 14092.** This is a boutique hotel about 15-18 minutes from Hyde Park Ice Pavilion. The rooms are extremely spacious with a complimentary breakfast included. Lewiston is also known for its many restaurants within walking distance of the hotel. The hotel is right on the water. This is a relaxing, resort area.

To book your reservation please **call 716-754-9070**. When calling please refer to KORN CAMP 2021 to take advantage of the discounted room rate of \$189.00 (weekdays) and \$239 (for Sat. night) per night. This rate will be available until **JUNE 17, 2021**. Rooms are limited. **Please act fast as these rooms sold out quickly in 2019, long before June.**

Of course, there are many hotel options in and around Niagara Falls.

Equipment

Remember, all goalies must have and properly wear, full, legal equipment. We will provide the on-ice jersey. For the off-ice activities, all goalies need sweats/shorts and sneakers along with **dry** socks, t-shirt and undergarments. ***At least 1 change of garments is required.***

The Final Day

We will have a ceremony on the final day of camp. All the parents are welcome. The ceremony is tentatively scheduled for 4:30 or 5:45pm based on the group. Awards will be presented.
