A full day will follow. The camp will end at approx. 5 pm daily.

Balance of Fees

Your **Registration/Confirmation acceptance was e-mailed to you**. Most pay a **Tuition Deposit** (\$100) to register. The **Balance of Fees** remain. All Balance of Fees along with a 5% "registration fee on the full tuition" will be charged to the credit card on file on **May 4**. All fees are in U.S. funds. Any change in credit card account numbers can be revised by logging into the online Registration site and your account which was established when you registered.

Refund Policy

- All cancellations must be made via a phone call or e-mail directly to Mitch Korn.
- All camp tuition (deposit and balance of fees) is accompanied by a 5% "Registration Fee" charged by the online service to cover credit card and administrative costs. All "Registration Fees" and your \$100 tuition deposit are **non-refundable & non-transferable**.
- All "balance of fees" (\$520 balance) will be refunded up to **3 weeks** (21 days) prior to the day camp begins with a written doctor's medical excuse. After that point, 80% of these "balance of fees" will be refunded with notification prior to the **7 DAYS BEFORE** camp begins.
- There is **no refund** of any fees should a player drop out of camp for any reason within the **7 days before camp begins**.
- Should a player be asked to leave camp by the Director for any reason, no refund will be made.
- All refunds will be credited back to the family credit card used to register.

Medical Form

The form can be printed from our website (www.mitchkorn.com) under the **CAMP FORMS** tab. **DO NOT MAIL IT BACK.** Bring it with you **totally completed** to **Check-In on the first morning.** Players cannot skate without it!

Local Host Hotel

The beautiful **LaQuinta Inn & Suites** at 11029 Dowlin Drive, Sharonville, Ohio 45241 is just a short distance from **NORTHLAND**. **This is our host hotel.** The hotel offers rooms with a mini frig / microwave / & coffee maker, pillow top mattresses, free wireless internet located throughout the hotel, an indoor pool, fitness center, and complimentary continental breakfast. The standard rooms with either 1 king bed or 2 double beds have a special rate of \$107.00 plus tax per night and the two room suites have a special rate of \$135.00 plus tax per night for our camp. Please call **513-771-0300** and ask for the "**Mitch Korn Hockey Goalie Group**" rate. We stay here! See you at the pool!

Lunches

Northland does not have a restaurant or snack bar for camp. We will organize a lunch package where we will bring in food daily for those who sign up. We will e-mail all participants the details once they are finalized prior to camp. The lunch package should be purchased in advance and paid at Check-In.

Locker rooms

We expect all goaltenders to **RESPECT** the facility, the staff, and the other participants. For females in the program, separate locker room facilities will be available. All goalies should be able to dress themselves. Parental assistance is allowed outside the locker room area only. With the number of goalies, space is VERY tight.

Equipment

Remember, all goalies must have and properly wear, full, legal equipment. We will provide the on-ice jersey. For the off-ice activities, all goalies need sweats/shorts and sneakers along with **DRY** socks, t-shirt and undergarments for following the ice sessions. At least 1 change of garments is required.

The Final Day

We will have a ceremony on the final day of camp. All the parents are welcome. The ceremony is tentatively scheduled for 4:20 pm. Awards will be presented.

Expectations

We will work hard to ensure that all participants have a fantastic experience. We expect all players to be willing and able to participate in all our activities, to follow the rules established, to have a good attitude and sense of humor, and to display camaraderie and sportsmanship.
