

ABOUT "KORN CAMP"

Back in 1977 Mitch Korn ran his first weekend Specialized Goaltender Program in Buffalo, NY. In between then and now, Mitch and the staff have developed this unique concept. These camps have now grown into the best in the country with 8 locations offered. Why not attend a program specially designed by position? In fact, it was Mitch's work in goalie camp that helped him land the job as the Sabres Goalie Coach in 1991.

MITCH KORN...celebrating 33 years in the NHL

Mitch is in his 6th year with the NY Islanders after 4 years with the Capitals. 16 seasons with the Predators and 7 seasons with the

Sabres...and he is a Stanley Cup Champion. His hard work, communication skills, ability to "dissect" a goalie's game, and great sense of humor have gained him the respect and friendship of those he has coached and worked with. Fondly referred to as "Children of the Korn" (a phrase coined by now Nashville GM Barry Trotz) these current and former goalies (many who are now coaching) have benefited from and helped spread the "goalie gospel according to Mitch". With Illya Sorokin's nomination in 2023 and Braden Holtby's earning of the 2016 Vezina Trophy, it marked

the 10th goalie nomination and 5th awarded Vezina for Korn as coach or director. Dom Hasek also won 2 MVP Hart trophies under Korn. He is the only coach in NHL history to coach a goalie to a Vezina with two different teams (Buffalo. Washington). Korn goalies have earned the 3 Jennings Trophies (fewest goals against) with the NYI (Lehner & Greiss), Buffalo (Fuhr & Hasek) and Caps (Holtby). Mitch has coached many present and former pros. Some include: Semvon Varlomov, Ilya Sorokin, Cory Schneider, Thomas Greiss, Chris



Gibson, Braden Holtby, Philipp Grubauer, Vitek Vanecek, Robin Lehner, Pekka Rinne, Carter Hutton, Devin Dubnyk, Scott Darling, Pheonix Copley, Parker Milner, Mike McKenna, Chris Mason, Dan Ellis, Marty Biron, Dominik Hasek, and Tomas Vokoun.

Mitch has coached and influenced others who have (in the past) or who are currently coaching professionally. Some include: Ben Vanderklok (Nash.), Scott Murray (Wash.), Steve Briere (Toronto), Wade Flaherty (Winnipeg), Alex Westlund (Detroit), Mike Bales (Buffalo), Olaf Kolzig (development for Wash.), Mike Dunham (AHL for Boston), Justin Peters (AHL for Ottawa), Drew McIntyre (AHL for Winnipeg), and Seamus Kotyk (AHL for Buffalo). Can anyone match his 33 years of goalie success in the NHL?

THE CAMP'S ORJECTIVE

Goaltending is more than just blocking. Our program will teach and drill the physical skills needed such as head tracking, shifting, full and half butterflies, power pushes, shuffles, transitions, recovery, stick skills, post play, etc., along with the mental skills such as save selections, "reading the play," angles, situational analysis, focus, etc. We provide a "full day" experience. A great staff is put together to assist Mitch. THERE IS NONE BETTER!

MITCH'S PHILOSOPHY

There is no substitute for hard work. Mitch works the goalies hard. But he also believes in having lots of fun. Humor is a big part of the teaching process. In addition, the goalies work together as a "fraternity" all camp. Mitch runs the camp and does a significant amount of the teaching.

THE CAMP'S FORMAT

The goalies receive 4 hours of ice time daily, plus 3 hours of structured off ice activities. Video is used to help teach and reinforce the skills of the day.

THE ON ICE PROGRAM

The ice time will be divided into 2 sessions. The first session is designed to teach and drill the skills of goaltending. The second session consists of "stations" with shooters and lots of pucks to help the goaltender "execute" on the skills taught. We use great training tools such as low & high shot screen boards, deflection boards, a deflection ramp, an on-ice mirror, glove weights, pro-angle, the med ball "goalie stabilizer," bungee balls, focus enhancers, a head tracking leash, on ice video and mini & white pucks.

OFF ICE PROGRAM

The goalies have 2 daily off ice sessions which include: video instruction, uniquely developed NHL videos to help teach "goalie sense," mental skill development, reading & reacting, how to handle many game situations, equipment innovations...and more!

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Goalies must supply their own, and always wear properly, full, legal equipment. A camp is provided. Goalies should be able to dress themselves for the ice. Parental assistance is permissible outside the locker rooms.

INSURANCE/MEDICAL

EACH PARTICIPANT MUST HAVE THEIR OWN MEDICAL

INSURANCE. Neither Mitch Korn nor anyone associated with Mitch Korn's Specialized Hockey Camps, Inc. will be responsible for any medical or dental insurance. Any accidents or illness will be treated at a hospital near the ice facility. Our medical insurance form is available on our website for each participant to print. A medical and liability release statement is included on this form. It must be completed and signed by a parent or quardian and brought to check-in on the first morning.

AGES, STRUCTURE, & ENROLLMENT

We accept ages 9 - adult, with the goalies grouped in "teams" by age and ability. All ice work is done as an individual, with a partner, or in a "station" of four. What you do is important, not what the goalie does next to you. Enrollment is limited and first come, first served. This is a commuter program... no housing is provided. Details on our host hotel are provided in the final information sheet on our website. Ages are as of Dec. 31, 2024. We sold out last summer. Two camps are offered. Camp 1 is July 5-8 and Camp 2 is July 10-13.

REGISTRATION / CONFIRMATION E-MAIL / CHECK-IN

All registration is on-line. Please see the **below** for full details. Once registered, you will receive an acceptance e-mail explaining how to access the camp final information sheet, and a medical form. CHECK-IN will be the first morning (Fri. or Wed.) at 7:40am. A full day will follow.

COST/DEPOSIT/REFUND POLICY

Cost per goaltender is \$825 (U.S. funds). A non-refundable deposit fee of \$100 is charged and is applied to your tuition. The payment balance is charged on May 5. The complete refund and payment procedure is part of the final information sheet. Full payment must accompany any new applications after May 5, should space be available.

On-Line Registration / Payment Details

- On-line registration begins **THUR. JAN. 18, 2024 at 9am (eastern)**
- all enrollment is on-line accessed via <u>www.mitchkorn.com</u> and by clicking the registration prompt on the left side
- Active Networks is the service provider
- all fees are paid via credit card
- the <u>deposit paid reserves your spot</u>. That deposit is credited to the full camp tuition and is <u>non-refundable and non-transferable</u>.
- the balance of fees (full tuition less deposit) will be charged to the credit card used to register on **May 5.**
- there is a 5% <u>"registration fee"</u> on the full camp tuition to cover credit card and admin. fees and is charged at the time you "pay in full". This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- most credit cards are accepted
- Whether you enroll in camp, or on a wait list, you will receive a
 <u>Confirmation E-mail</u> once the process is complete. If not,

- When you register, attempt to place the desired camp(s) in your cart quickly. You will have 14 minutes to log in or create an account and complete the personal application information.
- Should you end up on a wait list, your wait list position is based on when you <u>CHECK OUT</u>... so do that quickly. No credit card is required to get on a wait list
